GO MOBILE

As a result, students are motivated to continue to participate as often overlooked activities are finally given the chance to be recorded and celebrated.

INCORPORATE SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL LEARNING

Social and Emotional Learning really begins with the ability to identify how students are feeling in real-time. Follow-up surveys about student activities can provide administrators with an understanding of what the program did well in engaging students as well as opportunities for improvement. School districts can then easily identify programs and activities that receive low or high ratings, and correlate them with personal reflections to understand how students are feeling throughout their individual experiences.

LEVERAGE ANALYTICS

Data-driven decisions ultimately help schools to drive better student outcomes in the face of resource challenges.
